Guidelines for the photography competition

Ophthalmology category – Any ophthalmology related photo

Non- Ophthalmology category – Any theme

1. Author should be able to produce the original JPEG or RAW file.
2. Post-processing is limited to brightness / contrast / levels / curves / colour and noise correction/ burn or dodges.
3. The applicant should produce a printed copy and a softcopy along with the application. Softcopy can be handed over to the VR office in NEH.
4. Print should be within a **minimum width of 18 inches and maximum width of 24 inches.**
5. Portrait or landscape orientation permitted.
6. Prints in matte paper are preferred but gloss is also accepted. Lamination of prints not allowed.
7. Photos can be in monochrome or colour.
8. The soft copy should be a minimum of 6 megapixels and less than 20 MB. Should be produced in JPEG format.
9. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain written consent of any identifiable person / patient and should be producible upon request.
10. Message of maximum 50 words preferably and a title relevant to content in less than 5 words
11. Can be submitted for either of 2 categories or for both.
12. Photos that portray or otherwise include inappropriate and or offensive content, including violence, human rights violation, environmental violation and or any other content deemed to be contrary to law, cultural, religious or moral traditions are rejected from competition

Best photograph ophthalmology category and best photograph non ophthalmology category will receive valuable cash prize and a certificate.
